| 2. Interview the interviewee, asking questions about their name, background, friends, goals, and interest/reason for taking this course. | 2. Interview each interviewee, asking questions about their name, background, friends, goals, and interest/reason for taking this course. |
| 3. The observer becomes the interviewee and the interviewee becomes the observer. | 3. The interviewee of the first pair and the interviewer of the second pair form a new interviewee/interviewer pair, assuming the opposite role played the first time. The remaining pair also plays the opposite role. |
| 4. Repeat Step 2. | 4. Repeat step 2. |
| 5. Each observer must briefly introduce the interviewee to the class. | 5. Each interviewer must briefly introduce the person $\mathrm{s} / \mathrm{he}$ interviewed to the class. |
