Steps	
For Groups of Three	For Groups of Four
1. Decide who will be the interviewer, interviewee, and observer.	1. Break into two pairs of interviewer/interviewee.
2. Interview the interviewee, asking questions about their name, background, friends, goals, and interest/reason for taking this course.	2. Interview each interviewee, asking questions about their name, background, friends, goals, and interest/reason for taking this course.
3. The observer becomes the interviewee and the interviewee becomes the observer.	3. The interviewee of the first pair and the interviewer of the second pair form a new interviewee/interviewer pair, assuming the opposite role played the first time. The remaining pair also plays the opposite role.
4. Repeat Step 2.	4. Repeat step 2.
5. Each observer must briefly introduce the interviewee to the class.	5. Each interviewer must briefly introduce the person s/he interviewed to the class.
