1. Commands: How do you form the imperative tense? What makes commands different from the subjunctive tense both in terms of form and in terms of sentence structure? 2. Subjunctive: How do you form the subjunctive tense? Have we learned any acrostic that helps remember the irregular forms of this tense? When do you use the subjunctive? With exceptions like “ojalá” and “quizá”, how many clauses must there be in a subjunctive sentence? In which clause do you find the subjunctive tense? How is this related to subjectivity, doubt, and the hypothetical sense? Have you memorized the verbs and expressions that require the use of the subjunctive in the subordinate clause? Have you been careful enough when considering the use of words like “decir”, “dudar”, “creer”, and “negar”, both in terms of an affirmative and negative sentence?
